

Pool Rules

Pools generally open the first weekend in May and close for the season the last weekend in September.

Hours of Operation: 8am-9pm

- 1. THERE ARE NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- 2. The Association provides an access fob which is **REQUIRED** to enter the pool. Do not open the gates for anyone without an access fob.
- 3. TRESPASSING IS NOT ALLOWED. Violations will be enforced by the Little Elm Police Department.
- 4. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult age 18 or older.
- 5. Teens 16-17 years of age are limited to 2 guests.
- 6. Use of profane language will result in being asked to leave the pool and/or suspension of pool privileges.
- 7. Animals are not allowed in the pool area, per Town of Little Elm Health Code.
- 8. Each household allows 4 guests. Residents must accompany guests when using the pool. Homeowners who wish to have more than 4 guests must obtain prior written approval from the Association to reserve the pool/amenity center.
- 9. Bikes, scooters, and/or roller blades are not permitted inside the pool area.
- 10. No running, rough-housing, or aggressive behavior. Vandalism will not be tolerated.
- 11. Proper swimwear is always required. "Cut-Offs" are not allowed. Babies/toddlers must wear swim diapers. Please use the restrooms for any changing of clothes or swimwear.
- 12. Musical devices are only permitted with headphones. No speakers allowed.
- 13. Except for small snack items such as fruit, crackers, juice boxes, **FOOD IS NOT PERMITTED INSIDE POOL AREA**. Food may only be eaten outside at the picnic table area.
- 14. No smoking or alcohol is permitted.
- 15. Pool furniture is not permitted in the pool at any time.
- 16. Glass is NOT allowed in or around the pool area.
- 17. Keep safety equipment in its place. LIFE RINGS OR SHEPHERDS' CROOKS ARE NOT TOYS OR FLOATS.
